FROM SKETCH TO STUDIO

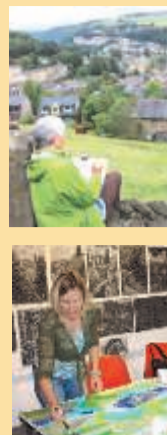
