This term we shall be relaunching Textiles as a key subject area at Northlight. Through the hard work, creativity and dedication of Sally Darlington, Creative Textiles courses developed as a very popular choice for many budding textile artists and identified Northlight as **the** place to come to push the artistic boundaries of the textiles medium.



The mantle is now being passed to Emma Wilkinson, an experienced textile artist who works with textiles and mixed media to create sculptural forms. She is looking forward to sharing her passion and knowledge to support others creativity through our new 'Art of Textiles' course and associated workshops.

The Tuesday morning class will encourage beginners and the more experienced to try out a wide range of techniques and approaches - so learning essential techniques whilst encouraging experimentation and an artistic outcome. Approaches covered this term will be machine embroidery, hot textiles, stitch and slash, with more techniques promised for the Autumn and beyond!

Emma will also be bringing her specialism of 3D Textiles to Northlight with a day workshop on 19th May which will give the opportunity to combine techniques to make a piece of 3D textile sculpture. We look forward to seeing textiles grow!

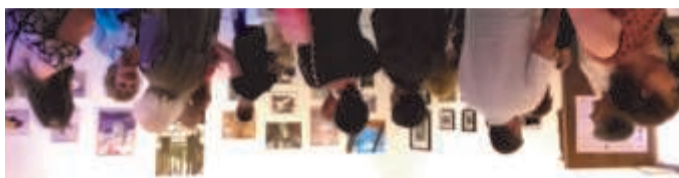


SHELF LIFE

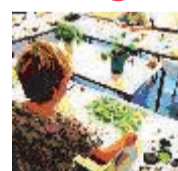
